

GBQHA RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Indemnity And responsibility: Neither GBQHA nor Baytown Fair Grounds, the show committee, nor any show official will be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse, participant, spectator, or to any article of any kind. The exhibitor shall indemnify the above mentioned parties against any and all loss, damages and liabilities including, but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof.**
- 2. Exhibitors and spectators are reminded that the show committee, officials and helpers are volunteers, without whose help the show would not be possible. Therefore, any abusive language or treatment of these volunteers will result in disciplinary action. First offense will receive a caution, second offense will result in ejection from show without a refund. No exceptions.**
- 3. Compliance with state health regulations is expected. All horses must have a current (within 12 months) negative coggins in hand or you will not be allowed on the premises.**
- 4. In order to be eligible for Series Awards you must become a paid member of GBQHA prior to your first class of the series.**
- 5. Proper riding attire is strongly suggested. English jackets & chaps are optional. Short sleeve shirts must have collars.**
- 6. A \$50 deposit is required to initiate a dispute. Deposit will be refunded if dispute is upheld. Decision will be made by GBQHA boardmembers and will be final.**
- 7. Points will be kept on a one-horse/rider combination.**
- 8. Correct number for horse/rider is to be worn and visible to the judge.**
- 9. No walk in classes. All entries must be made 1 to 2 classes in advanced or you will not be allowed to show in that class.**
- 10. Ring Steward must be notified to hold gate for a tack change or any other problems. Announcer will make every attempt for 3 gate calls, however, after final call, gate will be closed and judging will begin. You will not be able to enter the class once judging has begun.**
- 11. Any person practicing inhumane treatment of an animal or unsportsmanlike conduct (as deemed by the judge and committee) shall be asked to leave.**
- 12. All judges decisions will be final. Any request to speak to the judge is to be addressed to the ring steward.**
- 13. Classes will be divided when entries warrant, but may be combined when necessary.**
